



Who is eligible for CHSP?

For eligibility to access CHSP you will be assessed by the Regional Assessment Service (RAS) by an Aged Care Assessment team member, and your information registered with My Aged Care. If you're eligible for services under the CHSP, you can tell your assessor that you want to nominate ACCS as your service provider or request a referral code and contact us directly.

You may be eligible for CHSP if you are:

- having trouble doing everyday activities without help, and
- need support to live independently in the community

and are:

- 65 years or older (50 years or older and identify as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person) or
- 50 years or older (45 years or older for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people) and on a low income, homeless or at risk of being homeless.

If you are under 65 and require assistance at home, contact your local council directly, who will assist you with your enquiry and create a referral for an assessment.
